What kind of people are they? Adverbs Adverbs modify verbs, adjectives, and other adverbs. You can recognize adverbs easily because many of them are formed by adding -ly to an adjective, though that is not always the case. The most common question that adverbs answer is how. It tells us how she sang. It tells us how the cellist played. Adverbs also modify adjectives and other adverbs. Extremely is an adverb that modifies nice; it tells us how nice she is. How nice is she? Terribly is an adverb that modifies the adjective hot. How hot is it? Adverbs answer the question how. They can also answer the questions when , where , and why. Answering the question why usually requires an infinitive phrase. Adverbs cannot modify nouns, as you can see from the following incorrect sentences. What kind of man is he? In general, adverbs answer the following questions:
