Chad leaves the town. Dennis and Sandra realize a common love for Shakespeare and subsequently fall in love with each other "One Night With You"â€”reprise. Chad interrupts the wedding and declares his love for Natalie, though Natalie decides to not marry him and hit the open road. However, after some persuasion, Natalie agrees to make Chad her sidekick. The brides and grooms marry and everyone celebrates falling in love "Burning Love".
