Scoring Team Project Students will work in teams of to respond to a team-created research question; students will be evaluated on their individual contributions to the group, as well as the group as a whole. Teacher assessed; validated by College Board Individual Research- Based Essay and Presentation Students will be provided with source materials; students will use the source materials as a starting point for a researchable question.
