View Category Being able to read sheet music is a great skill that every guitar player should at least try to acquire. Reading on the guitar can be pretty difficult for some players. Many guitar players start trying to learn how to read sheet music only to get frustrated and quit. Try this lesson if you want to learn how to read guitar tabs. The lines and spaces that hold the notes. The lines above or below the staff that span beyond your E 4th string, 2nd fret and F 1st string, 1st fret. The acronym for remembering the spaces is the word FACE. The top number tells you how many beats are in a measure. In this case, there will be 4 quarter notes per measure. The horizontal lines that divide the sheet music into measures. You can keep dividing them down to get even shorter beats. Divided into different numbers of beats. The most common are whole note rests 4 beats , half note rests 2 beats , and quarter note rests 1 beat. These can also be divided down further. If you see a dot next to a note, all you have to do is take half the value of the note and add it to that note. For example, a half note with a dot next to it when be counted as 3 beats. These tell you to add the notes together and play them as if they were one note. Slurred notes are to be played legato. If you are meant to play a note with a certain finger, there will be a number beside the note telling you which finger you should use. Once you have learned how to read sheet music, you should learn how to play the most important guitar chords , how to read chord diagrams , how to read guitar rhythms , how to read guitar tabs , and how to read chord charts!
