

Chapter 1 : Book of Remembrance - Wakefield Crematorium - West Yorkshire

The book of remembrance is simply a concept God used to encourage His faithful ones that their love and service for Him was appreciated. It is His promise that, when His judgment comes against those who reject Him, He knows His own and will preserve them.

What "they that feared the Lord" said is not recorded; but it is implied, by His approval of them, that they strengthened one another in their faith and reliance on the goodness and faithfulness of the Lord, in spite of the present appearance of things. As the godless in Israel conversed together, so did the godly; but the converse of the one was the very reverse of the converse of the other. What they said is not repeated, but it was language well pleasing unto God, who deigned to listen to their words, and to console them by announcing the future destiny of the good and the evil. They may have argued with these impious talkers, and warned others against them; or they may have expostulated as Jeremiah The Septuagint and Syriac have, "These things spake they that feared the Lord," as if the two preceding verses reported the words of the pious. Some Fathers and commentators have taken the same view. But it is difficult to conceive such words coming from the mouth of those who fear God; unless they are so called ironically. A book of remembrance was written before God. He will take care that his children perish not with those that believe not. They shall be vessels of mercy and honour, when the rest are made vessels of wrath and dishonour. He will preserve them as his jewels, when the earth is burned up like dross. Those who now own God for theirs, he will then own for his. It is our duty to serve God with the disposition of children; and he will not have his children trained up in idleness; they must do him service from a principle of love. All are righteous or wicked, such as serve God, or such as serve him not: As to ourselves, we have need to think among which we shall have our lot; and, as to others, we must judge nothing before the time. But in the end all the world will confess that those alone were wise and happy, who served the Lord and trusted in Him.

There are different compartments of Hell, different levels of torture. Book of Tears " In Psalm 56 v. Book of Remembrance " This book is the one I want to spend the most time on. So many Christians think that just because they are saved, they are going to be raptured and marry YAHshua. There are certain requirements for one to be included in this Book and go in the Rapture. Some of the requirements are in Malachi 3 v. One has to think twice about committing a sin, because YAHweh will be displeased. To not obey Him, is something to be feared. It also helps us to stay close to Him by sharing what He has done for us to others. It also helps us to stay delivered from our sinful habits by testifying about how He set us free! We need to meditate on His Name. In this chapter in v. This term "make up jewels" really means to "take a journey. He says in the same verse that He will "spare them. Do you see how important it is to have your name written in the Book of Remembrance? In Acts 10 v. We need to stand for holiness in every aspect of our lives. Any problems that we may be having in the flesh we need to turn over to Him. We, through the Spirit can mortify the deeds of the flesh Romans 8 v. We are powerless against sin without Him. We have to turn over our weaknesses to Him. Only He can make our weaknesses to be strengths! In order to maintain a walk of holiness, we need to go into the Epistles Romans " Revelation and apply scriptures to our lives verbally. We need to speak them into our lives. This is how we cleanse ourselves! Our prayer life and giving, not only in terms of finances, but giving our time to Him are so important also in adding to the Book of Remembrance. Everything we do for Jesus in the areas that I mentioned in this message will add to this Book of Remembrance. God kept the king awake one night and had him open the book to the page where it was recorded what Mordecai had done Esther 6 v. When Haman came the next day to the King to have Mordecai killed, he was too late! The King had already purposed to bless Mordecai Esther 6 v. You can see in this message how important it is for our names and deeds to be written in the Book of Remembrance. So many think that that just because their names are written in the Book of Life, that they will go in the Rapture and be married to YAHshua. They are sadly mistaken! This life here is a courtship between YAHshua and us! My prayer is that you will seek YAHweh on this message and that you will ask Him to help make sure that you and your deeds are in the Book of Remembrance. We will have a seven year wedding with Him, when the rest of the world is in the Great Tribulation! I will summarize the requirements again: Fear YAHweh, speak often one to another about Him, think about His Name, continue a holy walk with His help , have an active prayer life and give to God, not only in finances but also, time.
