According to the Constitution of India, at the state-level, the governor is de jure head, but de facto executive authority rests with the chief minister.

She was an actress before her entry into politics and appeared in films which include Tamil, Telugu, and Kannada films. He is the president of the Telangana Rashtra Samithi, a regional party in India. He is the youngest individual to have held the office of Uttar Pradesh at the age of 38 years. Some of these are mentioned below: The CM holds the executive powers of state government. The core council of ministers is called the Cabinet, members of which are decided by the Chief Minister. The various departments are allotted to various ministers by the CM. The CM is the link between the Governor and the council of ministers. He is required to communicate to the Governor the workings of the various wings of the government. Similarly, the advice and suggestions of the Governor are communicated to the council of ministers by the CM. The CM has a pivotal role in the financial matters of a state, including the budget, basic infrastructural and developmental priorities of the state, financial planning and economic growth of the state and others. The Chief Minister is the chief spokesperson of the government of a state. With the help of media, the CM communicates all policies and decisions to the people of the state. All major decisions in the state are taken by the CM with the support of the council of ministers. The state government is financially aided by the Centre, in terms of resources and materials. Salary of Chief Minister The salary of Chief Minister of a state in India, like that of the prime minister of the country, is accompanied by a number of other allowances, besides the basic pay, such as constituency allowances, sumptuary allowances tax free and daily allowances. The salary of the CM is decided by the respective state legislatures in the country, as per Article of the Indian Constitution. Thus it varies from one state to another. Facilities availed by the Chief Minister The facilities given to the Chief Minister of a state can include medical facilities, residential facilities, reimbursement of electricity and phone charges, traveling facilities and many more. The amount allotted for each of these facilities to the Chief Minister varies from one state to another, as these are specifically detailed in the respective state legislatures of the country. In accordance with the Medical Attendance Rules, the Chief Minister is entitled to avail free medical treatment, reimbursement and free accommodation in all hospitals run by the Government and other referral hospitals declared by the government. The Chief Minister is entitled to a rent-free and well furnished residence. The amount, however, can vary in different states. In case, the Chief Minister decides to stay in his or her own house, the value of the house rental is paid to the Chief Minister. Reimbursement of electricity and phone charges: The Chief Minister is entitled to a fixed amount of money as reimbursement against phone call charges made in a month. A fixed quantity of electricity units are allotted free of cost to the Chief Minister, for the monthly consumption of electricity. The Chief Minister is allotted a fixed amount of money for his or her traveling expenses within the jurisdiction of the country, in a year. This amount also varies, as outlined in Article of the Indian Constitution. Selection Process of Chief Minister The appointing authority is the governor, who suggests a vote of confidence procedurally in the state legislature, to establish the selection of the Chief Minister. According to the Westminster model of parliamentary system that India follows, the Chief Minister is not elected directly by the people of a state. The people only elect particular representatives from various constituencies in a state, as members of the state legislature or the Vidhan Sabha MLAs. These representatives, especially from the majority party which forms the government, then choose the Chief Minister from among them. The tenure of the Chief Minister is for a period of five years, when the state legislative assembly is dissolved and fresh elections are held. However, the tenure of the Chief Minister can be terminated by the governor before the period of five years, when the majority party loses the confidence vote in the state legislative assembly. Term of Office and Retirement Age The tenure of CM is for five years, when the state legislative assembly is dissolved and fresh elections are held in the Vidhan Sabha Legislative Assembly. The Chief Minister can also resign from his or her post before the completion of the term. There is no age for the retirement of the Chief Minister. Although, the minimum age for becoming the Chief Minister is 25 years, there is no upper age limit till when he or she can serve the post of a Chief Minister. Pension of Chief Minister According to the Constitution of India, the Chief Minister of a state is entitled to a certain amount of pension after his or her retirement. However, the amount varies in the respective state legislatures. In the case of death of the Chief Minister, his or her spouse is entitled to pension

Remember, it does not mean Governor is free in the appointment of the Chief Minister. Governor has no real alternative open to him because after general election to the State Legislative Assembly, the party or coalition group which secures majority in this House elects its leader and converse his name to the Governor. What is the Tenure of Chief Minister in India? Tenure of the CM of India is maximum for five years. The Chief Minister remains in place of work so far he is sustained by the majority of the members of the Legislative Assembly. The CM gives notice resigns when the majority in Legislative Assembly goes against him. What are the Powers and function of Chief Minister? Formation of the Council of Ministers: Chief Minister is having power of forming a ministry of his choice. As per Constitution, he is having freedom to choose his ministers. He is responsible for appointing any member or even a non-member as a minister and allocates him any portfolio. Distribution and Change of Portfolios Departments among the Ministers: Subsequent to appointment of ministers, the next chief function of the Chief Minister is the distribution of portfolios among them. He is responsible for deciding who will be a Cabinet Minister or a Minister of State. He is accountable for allocating departments to ministers. Besides this, he is also liable for changing the department of any minister. Even ministers keep CM informed about the working of their departments. You Can Also Check: Chief Minister supervises over the meetings of the Cabinet. He is allotted with duty of deciding agenda of its meetings. Thereafter, he communicates it to the ministers and then presides over these. So, he is having utmost importance in State. The ministers remain in place of work all through the pleasure of Chief Minister. The administrator cannot eliminate ask any minister to give notice if he is not happy with his work. He can make an accusation in his Council of Ministries whenever he likes. Role as Leader of the State Legislative Assembly: Chief Minister is one of the premier leaders not only of his party but also of the Legislative Assembly. He is responsible for leading House in the right direction. Besides this, he also acts as a spokesman of the government and responsible for making crucial announcements of his government. Chairman of the cabinet: The director cannot take part in the conference of cabinet. The CM calls the conference of the Cabinet and presides over its meeting. He also organized and controls the agenda for cabinet assembly. The Cabinet takes its judgment unanimously and normally the views of the Chief Minister carry weight. Cabinet Ministers of India Leadership in the cabinet in the Legislative: CM can attend the conference of both the Houses and can take part in their working. The members of administration ask questions to cabinet members and criticize their policies and actions. When a minister cannot give agreeable reply to criticism of a member, Chief Minister assists the minister in fulfilling the member. The significant resolution taken by Cabinet is publicized in the Legislative by CM. Resulting to every general election, Governor Selects the leader of the majority party in the State Assembly or as is often the case, the leader of a mixture of parties forming alliance, the Chief Minister of the state.
