Is it possible for Christians to tap into these stories of the night and receive deeper insight into their waking lives? Many people believe that dream interpretation belongs to the realm of the psychics and psychoanalysts. The Bible, however, reveals to us that dreams are one of the ways that God speaks to us Job There were two people in the Bible who actually interpreted dreams - Joseph and Daniel. King Nebuchadnezzar and Pharaoh both had dreams, and no one could interpret them except Joseph and Daniel who realized that the true interpretation came only from the Spirit of God. In both instances the popular dream interpretive methods of that day could not correctly interpret a dream from God Genesis We have found that this is still the case today. Most dream interpretation methods and the explanatory books offered today use a Freudian or Jungian approach. These methods are not biblical and according to them, a dream does not come from the Spirit of God, but rather from our own soul or psyche. Therefore, if you try to apply these methods to a dream already interpreted in the Bible, you will not interpret it in the way God intended. I do not recommend using dream symbol books that derive their meanings from these methods. Jesus often taught people by using parables, which are stories with a deeper spiritual meaning. He admonished his disciples that they must be able to interpret parables and understand this type of symbolic thinking in order to uncover the mysteries of the Kingdom Matthew Dreams are symbolic and are basically night parables. The first place to look to understand the symbols found in our dreams is the Bible. For instance, depending upon the context in the dream, a tree can represent a leader Daniel 4: But what do we do when we come across a symbol in a dream that is not defined in the Bible? We must then learn to think metaphorically. Jesus gives us some insight into how to understand things symbolically in Matthew When they went across the lake, the disciples forgot to take bread. But be on your guard against the yeast of the Pharisees and Sadducees. Most people miss the fact that Jesus was giving us a major clue to understand parables and even the symbolism found in dreams. A car can represent our life or career. A jet plane can represent a church or a ministry. Being late can symbolize a warning not to miss something important. Taking a test can give us a clue that we are being tested. After interpreting thousands of dreams for people, I have noticed that there are a few common dream themes that I hear on a regular basis. Some of the common dreams are flying, teeth falling out, falling, going to the bathroom, to name a few. I began to recognize that the meanings of these dreams show where many people are today spiritually. For instance, flying indicates a high destiny in God; teeth coming loose or falling out may mean there is a need for wisdom or advice; falling may indicate feeling out of control of a situation; going to the bathroom is the need for spiritual cleansing or flushing forgiveness. As we understand the meaning of dreams, we can help other people find their destiny in God. Although not all dreams are from God, people everywhere are having dreams, and many of the dreams which people share with us have been divinely given. I have been leading prophetic and dream interpretation outreach events for several years. We are finding that people everywhere are very interested in knowing what their dreams mean. As they share their dreams, their walls of resistance come down and they become very open to talking more about God. Since people today consider themselves spiritual, being able to interpret their dreams accurately through the Spirit of God is proving to be an evangelistic goldmine. Well there is a way. Imagine finding ways where we can use that time to communicate with God and deepen our relationship with Him. Dreams are one of the ways that God uses to communicate with us, but I am sure that there are more. When you are dreaming, you are quiet. You are not distracted. You are not trying to figure out in your head whether this is really God, although that may well occur when you awake from a dream. The Bible has a bit to say about sleep: Thus prepare with positive habits in your preparation and a clear conscience. My sleep had been pleasant to me. Dreams occur whilst asleep. Visions are vivid images whilst praying and awake. Practices to implement for hearing God overnight: Expect God to speak to you. Pray as you lie down to go to sleep. Confess any known sin. Worship Him and focus your thoughts on Him. Ask God to show Himself to you throughout the night. Ask God to communicate with you through new ways, how He wants to, whilst you are asleep. Ask God to give you new strategies for problems you are facing in the daytime, strategies to save you time the next day. Ask God to romance your soul and spirit overnight with His love, His goodness and His mercy. As soon as you awaken, record any dreams, thoughts, new ideas. Focus on God, not on the dreams. Take note of the words you say about your sleep. Change your words to a positive declaration about how great a sleep you have and how God speaks to you at night. We can build walls around areas of emotional pain to shield us from more perceived hurt but God can use dreams to bypass those walls. Promises revealed in dreams give us the determination to push through difficult circumstances so that we will continue until we see the promises fulfilled. There is no one formula for interpreting dreams. There are some keys that do help though. Focus on a healthy relationship with the Holy Spirit who is the author and interpreter of dreams. Seek Godly counsel from experienced interpreters of dreams. Pay attention to how you feel when you first wake up, and the time. Just the main points and any significant people in your dream. Ask God to highlight to you the colours, sounds, smells, taste, feel and what it means at this time. You could also do this activation asking God who the picture is for and then sharing it with that person. Ask God to identify a particular person to you who is struggling with an issue. Ask God to then reveal to you the key that will unlock the answer to the issue that person is struggling with. Share the key with this person at the appropriate time.
