God will always act on His Word. An argument goes that a believer cannot be cursed because Jesus became the curse for us on the Cross. This is true, but the bottom line is, we do become soft targets for attack if walking in the flesh, as we are opening doors for the enemy to creep in. This will happen as long as Satan is operating on Planet Earth. I notice if I grumble about people, I would come under a lot of attack in the days to come. This is not because I was negative but rather, the devil was waiting for that moment in my life of weakness to walk in and attack me, because he knows how I love the Lord and oh how he hates me.
