

Chapter 1 : The Awe of God: Hindrances to hearing God

Every Believer has been predestinated to be like the Son. Sanctification is the process of becoming more and more like Jesus. To Him be glory both now and for ever. Our day-to-day needs have been ordained by God to cause us the necessity of discovering some new aspect of the character of the LORD Jesus that we may lay hold of by means of the Exceeding Great and Precious Promises. Rees Howells, a Welsh coal miner who exemplified intercessory prayer, understood that need to please God and recorded: God requires man to live by faith. All men have a moral likeness to their Creator. That likeness means the ability to make a moral decision of choosing or rejecting good or evil. No, that does not make one a child of God without repentance and faith. But, even with this God-given capacity of every man to choose or reject God, man never does what he should without the gracious intervention of God. Our claiming of the Promises only occurs with the continual help of God. In this fashion, God rightly demands us to exercise faith in our own salvation and sanctification, while giving us His help freely, as a Father to a child, to ensure our likeness to the Only Begotten Son. Through Jesus "we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand" Romans 5: The Veracity of God promise assumes the veracity and ability of the one who makes the promise to keep it. What is Scripture but the account of a Faithful God dealing with man? Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of His Counsel, confirmed it by an Oath: That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us" Hebrews 6: What "two immutable things" are meant by Hebrews 6: God cannot lie because He has chosen not to lie. God is what He is because He has chosen to be so, not because someone else caused Him to be that way. Thus, He is what He has chosen to be, and deserves the greatest honor and credit for being the Faithful God. The Father has made the deposit. His authorizing signature is His Word. Your name has been carefully included on the line, "Pay to the Order of". To ensure no difficulty in your cashing of the check, our Loving Heavenly Father has written your name as "Whosoever Will"-- "whosoever will, let him take the Water of Life freely" Revelation All that remains is your cooperation, in endorsing your signature on the back of the check, to tell the Bank that you have accepted the check. This can only be done by faith. What hinders us from claiming the Promises of God? The absence of faith. Sometimes we refuse to believe what God has said-- for whatever selfish reason. Other times, we simply lack the faith to honestly believe because we do not understand the Promise. And seek not ye what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink, neither be ye of doubtful mind. For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you. After we have claimed the Promises, we may falter because we become impatient. That too, is sin. But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing" James 1: Gaining from God the very thing we desired and for which we prayed the Promises, has the added benefit of God perfecting us to be more like the LORD Jesus. For instance, we have been promised prosperity and success, but on the condition that we abide in the Word of God. We have been promised a secure and happy family, but on the condition of fearing i. We have been promised escape from the Tribulation Week as understood from Daniel 9 and Matthew 24 , but on the condition of our continual watching and praying that we would be accounted worthy to escape. The examples are endless. With all the love that He lavished upon our original parents in their Edenic Paradise, it must have truly pained Him to cause death to fall upon Adam and Eve after they ate the Forbidden Fruit. Noah "being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house" Hebrews Jehovah said, "I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth" Genesis 6: He promised Noah the delay of years before the Flood would come, which was enough time to build the Ark. The Promised Land is Israel. Though Abraham was promised to possess all the land on which he dwelled, he was still only "a stranger and a sojourner" Genesis By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise" Hebrews What motivated Abraham

to continue living as a stranger in the land that God had promised him as a possession? Abraham looked for an eternal dwelling with his God. In other words, Abraham was patient about receiving the Promised Land from God because He was motivated by the higher desire to dwell with God forever. Rahab is another excellent example of how God has kept His Promises. And it shall be, when the LORD hath given us the land, that we will deal kindly and truly with thee" Joshua 2: Rahab had a further condition to fulfill in addition to her silence about the whereabouts of the two spies. And it shall be, that whosoever shall go out of the doors of thy house into the street, his blood shall be upon his head, and we will be guiltless: And if thou utter this our business, then we will be quit of thine oath which thou hast made us to swear. And she said, According unto your words, so be it. And she sent them away, and they departed: Because Rahab fulfilled the conditions for her promised preservation, she not only received her life in the bargain, but was one of the direct ancestors of King David and the LORD Jesus Christ. Truly our God is "able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the Power that worketh in us" Ephesians 3: Thank God for the faith of Rahab! Also, consider the fact that we can only stand on the Promises in the present tense. It is appropriate to say that we have stood on the Promises in the past and will stand upon them in the future, but only today can we say that we are Standing on the Promises of God. If we cannot have a present victory in our dependance on the Promises of God, the past and the future lose significance. May we be as presently optimistic as Brother Paul when he announced to his fellow lost-at-sea shipmates their certain deliverance. If God is presently sustaining us, then we have confidence in God. Walking by faith, claiming the Promises, and believing God, all describe confidence in God. Pray that God will give us a strong grip on Himself. What a wonderful prayer that God will most willingly grant! Can we lose our reward? Our confidence in God and in His Promises has great reward. When we backslide from the LORD, we lose ground from where we were previously standing. We need Promises from God to ensure our continual cleaving to His Promises! How can we await an appointed time of departure from this earthly abode without confidence in God? The promise of our LORD coming to take us before the Tribulation Week begins is further founded upon our confidence that He is able to subdue us to Himself. How could we be ready otherwise? Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto His glorious body, according to the working whereby He is able even to subdue all things unto Himself" Philippians 3: What an ecstatic relieving of a great burden will our departure be! A present tense confidence in God and His Promises is necessary for our prayers to be answered. And if we know that He hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him" 1John 5: The mighty men of faith and prayer of the past such as George Muller and Hudson Taylor have taught the Church to expect great things from God-- and to attempt great things for God. They will be waiting in Heaven with the Saviour to welcome us as soldiers of the Promises, who have come home. The Immutability of God assures us that He will most assuredly perform all of His promised prophecies. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof" Matthew 6: But why should we be so unconcerned about the evil that could befall us tomorrow? Because our God is demonstrating His sustaining power through His Promises toward us today. How could we be in a state of Spiritual readiness as Wise Virgins Matthew He that feareth is not made perfect in love" 1John 4: Your faith in God honors Him, and He will likewise honor you with the fulfillment of His Promises in answer to your prayers. He has promised eternal happiness for His people. The wicked are promised eternal suffering. Those who are walking in righteousness are promised to be delivered from the upcoming Tribulation Week, while the backslidden and the wicked will not escape it. The Foolish Virgins i. Shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day? All Israel is promised to be finally saved. Conclusion promise need not start with an "If" to be a promise. Michael Bradley Sometimes God will not move to heal someone due to some type of block or hindrance. Once this person finds out what that block or hindrance is and gets it properly removed, then many of the time God will move back in to fully heal them. The following verses will give you some major insight into what some of these hindrances and blocks can be. Again, study these verses very carefully and make sure you do not have any of these possible hindrances before approaching God for your own personal healing. The first block, and this is a major one, is the sin of unforgiveness. As you will see in the following Scripture verse, God the Father will not even begin to hear any of your own personal prayers if you are holding any kind of unforgiveness towards anyone. And if God will not hear any of your own personal prayers “ then you will have little or no chance of getting any type of divine healing from Him. This particular sin is one that God really does not like. The fact that He specifically isolates this sin in reference to your personal prayer life in the following Scripture verse is showing you the extreme importance of it, and that He does not want you holding any type of unforgiveness towards anyone else “ no matter how bad anyone else may have ever hurt or wronged you in your past. However, once that unforgiveness has been properly taken care of and removed, then God will move in to heal that person. If you are operating in this specific sin and are holding any type of serious grudges or unforgiveness towards anyone else “ then you will need to go before God the Father, confess this sin out, and then tell Him that you will now fully forgive all of the specific people who have ever wronged you in your past. If you are willing to take this kind of powerful stand with the Lord, then over the course of time God will start to take out the negative emotions of that unforgiveness, and pretty soon you will no longer even feel this unforgiveness towards that person like you had in the past. God will do inner spiritual surgery on the inside of you to remove all of those negative feelings. Here is the verse. But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses. These next 6 verses will follow-up very nicely to the above verse on unforgiveness. If you are out cheating on your spouse operating in the sin of adultery, then there is a very good chance that God may not hear any of your prayers. And if God is not hearing any of your personal prayers to Him, then you may not be able to receive a divine healing from Him when you will really need one. So if you are really serious about wanting to approach God the Father for a divine healing, the first thing you must do is make sure that you do not have any sins that may need to be forgiven and washed clean under the Blood of Jesus. You may want to ask the Holy Spirit to help you out. Ask Him to show you if there are any sins that you may not be aware of that will need to be confessed, forgiven, and washed clean under the blood of Jesus. If you are willing to go this far with the Lord, then you may have just removed any major blocks or hindrances in being able to receive a divine healing from Him. You may have just dramatically increased your chances of now being able to receive a divine healing from God. Here are the verses. For I am the Lord who heals you. There is simply no sugarcoating what these verses are trying to tell us. Even though all of our past, present, and future sins will be fully forgiven under the blood of Jesus, we still have to make every concerted effort on our end to try and stay out of sin. And once we know that we have fallen into a specific sin, then we have to recognize it and admit it before the Lord, and then confess it out to Him as a sin so we can receive His full forgiveness for it. I believe one of the main reasons why more people do not receive divine healings from the Lord may be due to sins that may not have yet been forgiven because they have not been recognized as actual sins, or that person is unwilling to have their sins be properly dealt with by God the Father. A person may be operating in the sin of adultery and he simply does not want to give it up. And until he does, there is a very good chance that God will not be hearing any of his prayers, especially in the area of divine healing. This is why I strongly recommend that anyone who is seeking after a major miracle from God in the area of divine healing “ that you ask the Holy Spirit to help you out in discovering what those sins may be that will need to be confessed and forgiven with God the Father. This

strategy right here may be the difference as to whether or not you receive a full divine healing from the Lord.

22 For in my inner being I delight in God's law; 23 but I see another law at work in the members of my body, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within my members.

Any Unconfessed Sin It would be well if each of us kept a record of the time spent in prayer during just one week. It might convince us of how little praying we really do. This is an age in which records are kept anyhow. The farmer records the number of bushels of grain produced per acre; the teacher records the progress of her pupils; the businessman records his inventory of stock. And it might be profitable if we kept a record in the matter of prayer. If we are inclined not to do it, the reason might be related to the fact that we know how embarrassing the record could be. Jesus prayed often, and if He found praying necessary in His life, surely prayer ought to have a significant place in the lives of each one of us! To simply begin the day with a few lines, and to close it with a couple routine wordsâ€”is not the effectual fervent prayer that should characterize the true believer. Mothers can lift up their concerns to God in prayer while mending clothes and waxing floors and preparing meals. Fathers can meet God in behalf of that boy away in grade school, or the married daughter who is now raising a family of her own, while working with a bale of hay, or laboring at a workbench, or sitting at a desk in the office. We must cultivate the habit of being constant in an attitude of prayer. The normal Christian life should be a life of regular, daily answer to prayer. While answered prayer should be the normal experience, it remains a fact that many times we fail to get the answer to the cry of our hearts. Sometimes there are certain hindrances that cause God to withhold the request we ask. The first thing that hinders prayer and causes God to withhold what we ask, is a selfish purpose in our praying. If we pray simply for the gratification of self and for the satisfaction of our own pleasures, the Bible says we ask amiss. You remember the story that amused us when we were children. It was the story of a wishing cap, and when the possessor wore the cap, he was vested with the power of obtaining immediately what ever he wished for. They think God is pledged to satisfy all their selfish desires and that He ought to lavishly give them everything they ask. There was a time, for example, when I prayed for a Rolls-Royce. The motive was quite obvious; I was eager to show off. Surely it is best that God never gave me the chance to sit behind the wheel of such an elaborate automobile. Sometimes folks desire great wealth and pray that God will bless them financially. It may be all right to pray for success and prosperity in business, but we must be very careful to examine our motives and see that they are proper. God knows the motive of the heart, and He loves us too much to entrust us with riches, when He knows we would spend them on our own pleasures, and thus let them become a detriment to our souls. Sometimes a Christian wife prays for the conversion of her unsaved husband. But as proper as that prayer isâ€”it is often hindered because the wife who offers it is praying for the conversion of her husband from a purely selfish motive. She says to herself: No two persons can know the deepest joys of married life, when one is a Christian and the other is not. But for a wife to pray for the conversion of her husband for those reasons alone, is selfish. James says that sometimes we do not receive the answers to our prayers because we are too selfish in our praying. We ask and receive not because we ask amiss, that we might consume it on our own pleasures. A General Indifference Toward the Bible If our hearts are turned away from the Scriptures, and the Bible fails to be of any interest to us, then our prayers are going to be an abomination. After all, how can anyone who is not interested in the Bible; who fails to read it; whose heart is turned away from it; how can he ever please God in prayer? And John says in 1 John 5: God says we should ask according to His will. Ignorance of the Bible and its basic teachings accounts for many hindered prayers. God has expressed His mind far too clearly in the Bible concerning the matter of rooting out inbred sin, to let us be familiar with the Scriptures and at the same time pray a prayer like that. An Unforgiving Spirit Toward Others Jesus states plainly that Christians who will not forgive others, will not be heard themselves when they ask forgiveness. Jesus says in Mark There are some Christians who would never attend a theater and never belong to a lodge and never play a game of bridgeâ€”but who at the same time are guilty of the sin of unforgiveness. It is easy to brood over past differences just enough to keep our wrath warm. If we pray while holding bitterness in our hearts toward others, our prayers are really hypocritical, and God has not promised to hear.

We are to completely forgive others. And yet in almost every congregation of believers there are persons who refuse to speak to others, and who are so gripped with the sin of holding bitterness in their hearts that they have made shipwreck of their lives. If we want our prayers answered, we must learn to completely forgive. God has never promised to answer the prayer of one who harbors an unforgiving spirit. Discord in the Home Contention and misunderstandings in the home become a hindrance to an effective prayer life. Many times this hindrance is overlooked. Peter in 1 Peter 3 speaks about the conduct of husbands and wives, and tells us that an inconsistent life in the home will cause our prayers to be hindered. The wife must be subject to her husband or her prayers will be hindered. The husband is to dwell with his wife according to the knowledge that she is the weaker vessel, or his prayers will be hindered. Harmony in the home is tied into receiving the answers to our prayers. When two unite in marriage, God views them as one flesh. He expects them to think together and to plan together and to pray together—and if there is disharmony and a lack of agreement, prayers are going to be interrupted. We should never let the sun go down on a family squabble because it is like a snowball—the farther it rolls, the larger it will grow. Discord in the home, grieves God. If there is a lack of harmony and a lack of agreement in your home, your prayer-life will be hindered. We can make all kinds of pretense about piety. How many a man is there who, if you heard him talk in prayer meeting or in the Sunday School class, you would think he is a perfect saint of God. His words are so winsome and winning and earnest. But in his home he is quite different. Some men who are angels in public are devils at home—and then they wonder why their prayers are hindered. The husband is tired when he comes home from work. He puts his hands into his pockets and finds the letter still there. You always forget to mail it! You never do what I ask you to do! No wonder prayers are hindered. True—many homes are burdened with family members who are not Christians—and many times there is a lack of cooperation on the part of the unbeliever. In such cases, the Christian partner must continue to pray, and God does graciously answer. But remember—it never helps to nag and constantly criticize the one who is slow to cooperate. Our sweet reasonableness in the midst of tense moments, will have tendencies to win the unbeliever. Any Unconfessed Sin A final factor that hinders the answer to prayers is any unconfessed sin. We have pointed out a number of sins thus far which are mentioned in the Bible as hindering the answer to prayer. These include praying with selfish motives, harboring an unforgiving spirit, and allowing discord in the home. There are other reasons why prayers are hindered. These include a lack of faith failure to believe that God will answer, an unwillingness to help answer the prayer, and a failure to pray with uncovered head for men, and with the veiled head for women. God may do more than He promised, but He never promised to answer the prayers of those who disregard His order in headship. Finally, however, it must be pointed out that any unconfessed sin can block the answer to our prayers. No Christian can ever be successful in prayer if he practices sin in his life—if he knows he is doing wrong and he is not willing to confess his transgression. True—all of us have sinned. But if we hold to a sin, and love it, and make an alibi for it, and excuse it—then that puts a separation between God and me. It short-circuits the communication system, and I am just wasting my time even trying to pray. Look back into the dark recesses of your heart and mind. It may be some questionable habit; or some petty jealousy; or carelessness; or lustful passion. It may be the love of money, or some shameful secret sin in your life. Perhaps only you and God know about it. If you love a sin, and if in your heart you are excusing it—it is going to hinder your prayers and stop heaven and shut the ears of God so that He will not hear. The solution is to get it confessed and forsaken, and to restore fellowship with God. Prayer is a communication system almost like a telephone between us and God. An older friend in Christ said to me one time: A Christian night-attendant in a city drugstore tells of his experience with prayer. The store was open all night to fill emergency prescriptions. The attendant slept on a couch at the rear of the store, and one who wanted service during the night rang a buzzer at the front door. The attendant was just about sleeping one dark, rainy, dismal night—when he was aroused by the buzzer. After the boy had gone, the pharmacist put away the bottles and recorded the prescription—only to notice to his horror that he had given the boy a deadly poison, instead of the medicine he had intended to give. The pharmacist did not know which way the boy had gone; it was raining and dark outside; he looked in the phone book, but there was no name to match his record. He then lay down again. Soon the night attendant was aroused by the buzzer again.

Unholy lifeâ€™” Sin separates. It creates enmity between God and man; and in human relationships. Many are looking to holistic healing by eating health foods and supplements which are also helpful. How does this hinder receiving healing from God? It hinders because it leads most Christians to believe that faith in God and in His Word are irrelevant to getting healed. The doctrine of Predestination coincides with this doctrine. If that is actually true, then it would be wrong for us to go see a doctor or use medicine to try to get well. This thinking is irrational, unscriptural and faith killing! This theology teaches that God can and does heal, but you never know what God will do. This teaching pervades nearly all mainline denominations. They use the NIV and other translations. The Ecumenical movement has assimilated the traditionalists. The problem is that that it is not prayer in itself that heals you. Prayer and faith gives you access to Him. A major thing that went wrong here was that most of the emphasis of these revivals was put on the preacher and healing and little on salvation. They use sensationalism making it look like they are the miracle workers and emphasize how much power they have. The problem is that many are looking for a person with the Anointing or Gift of Healing, Miracles or Knowledge to get healing, instead of primarily looking at the promises of God from the Bible and to Jesus. The deception of these movements is that most of them will actually quote parts of the Bible, but the bottom line is that they partially quote the scriptures and do not believe in the divinity of Christ. These cults often look biblical, yet, in reality they are New Age, a pop psychology counterfeit copycat of the Bible. They use half- truths or no one would listen to them. The problem is that they pervert the truth. This is where the NIV and other translations line up with them; i. It leaves Jesus out as our healer and replaces Him with your mind. This is humanist self-healing, mind over matter and cultish. Some involved in these cults have even rejected medical science. Positive Thinking is important and helps people to achieve a lot of things and to be upbeat about life. What was overlooked by most Christians, is that Peale and Schuller were not pointing people to Jesus or the promises of God from the Bible to get healing, etc. Jesus name was being mentioned, but just as a cloak to teach the mind sciences. This new wave became popular because it opposed dead denominational Christianity, which had rejected the gifts of the Spirit. It appealed to the Pentecostals because they were traditionally poor and many lived defeated lives. It also emphasizes the Gifts of Healing, Miracles and Knowledge. It de-emphasizes prayer and uses Mark This new wave mocks the KJV and uses many translations. Faith is important because it gives us access to God, but faith in itself does not heal us. The power to receive supernatural miracle comes from God, not a humanistic type of faith. God and Prayer are not in their formula.
