Vovinam is a Vietnamese martial art founded by Nguyen Loc. Later, his family moves to Hanoi. When Nguyen Loc starts going to school, his father asks an old master to teach Nguyen Loc the traditional martial arts and wrestling techniques for health and self-defense reasons. Nguyen Loc grows up in the period which Vietnam is still under the French colonial rule. At that time, young men either are seduced by the French into the lusty lives or join the revolutionary war against the French. Master Nguyen Loc believes that the only way to free Vietnam from the colonial rule is to train the Vietnamese young men to have a strong, invincible will for liberty and independence. That would must be produced by a strong body and a rational mind. Therefore, he begin his missions to train the Vietnamese youth to have a moral and invincible spirit: He also examines tirelessly many archives about Philosophy, Literature, History, In addition, he always attends many tournaments and competitions or discusses martial arts with many famous masters. In , He and his disciples demonstrates publicly for the first time in the Great Theater of Hanoi. The demonstration is very successful and attracted many spectators. Many Vovinam disciples in the period of often tell of the tale of the "invincible spirit" of Founder Nguyen Loc. In the first demonstration, there is a high ranking French official, Colonel Maurice Ducoroy, attending. During the demonstration, Dr. Knowing that he could not refuse, Founder Nguyen Loc has to accept. But when he returns to the stage, he calmly puts the medal into his pocket. His conduct has touched the patriotic feelings of the audience, especially his disciples. Since then, Vovinam always leads the demonstrations against the French and its rule, including the demonstration in the University of Hanoi and the Ministry of Agriculture. Consequently, French closes all the Vovinam classes and prohibits Founder from teaching Vovinam. This is a challenging period for Vovinam during its early time. However, Founder still secretly teaches many loyal disciples at home, and continues to lead many public demonstrations. Soon later, Vovinam cooperates with many patrioting organization to host many events commemorating King Hung first King of Vietnam , Two Queens Trung as well as many charitable events At the same time, many self-defense classes have opened and recruit tens of thousands of disciples. The enthusiasm for Vovinam in the public is indicated by the slogans: At this time, since the independence war is necessary, many Vovinam techniques are very simple but practical. The training focuses on the endurance, speed, and strength. Most of the training sessions last about 3 months. In April , many Vovinam instructors are sent to remote places to promote Vovinam. On December 19, , the war against France breaks out in North Vietnam. Founder Nguyen Loc leads his disciples to join the war. Some disciples become famous and courageous commanders while some have fallen for the freedom of Vietnam. When Viet Minh the predecessor of the Vietnamese Communist Party begins to consolidate their power by recruiting non-communist Vietnamese and murdering those who refuse, Founder Nguyen Loc immediately halts all his involvements with Viet Minh and urges his disciples to leave the Viet Minh. Upon the dangerous situation: He then takes the remaining disciples back to his hometown, Huu Bang village. In his hometown, he helps organize the young men into militias as well as train the new militias in combative techniques. In August , He returns to Hanoi and opens many Vovinam classes for the young men and women. In , He works with many dignitaries to found the Vietnamese Martial Artist Federation which offers many martial art classes for the public in the schoolyard of Hang Than, Hanoi. In July 20, , the Geneva Treaty divides Vietnam into two countries: This event poses a great challenge to Vovinam in general and the Founder in particular. If Founder decides to stay in the North, Vovinam would be falling into the hand of the Communists. If He decides to head to the South, many disciples would leave their families and hometowns behind, and Vovinam would lose many able disciples who decides to stay. On the other hand, the South is still a unknown land, and the Founder would risk losing everything he builds from and would start from scratch; and no one really knows what is awaiting. Finally, Founder Nguyen Loc decides to migrate to

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the South and start Vovinam once again under unfavorable conditions. In July , Founder and loyal disciples arrive in Saigon, and open new Vovinam school here. In the middle of , Founder fall sick and has to take a break from teaching. He authorizes the oldest disciple, Master Le Sang to take over the Vovinam classes temporarily. Although Founder is not physically teaching Vovinam, He is still doing researches, and analyzing Vovinam techniques as well as essential archives in order to refine Vovinam. Founder still looks after the disciples who are following his mission. Master Le Sang also gathers many disciples of the early classes to help develop Vovinam. While the progress of Vovinam discipline has just begun and there are still many tasks to overcome, Founder Nguyen Loc unexpectedly passes away on April 29, April 4, , year of the Rat, according to Lunar Calendar. Before passing away, Founder Nguyen Loc appoints his most senior disciple, Le Sang, to continue his missions. Then on every April 4 lunar calendar , all the disciples gather in front of his tomb to pay respect to him. On , since Master Pham Loi of Judo participates in the coupe led by General Nguyen Chanh Thi, the Ngo administration prohibits many martial art disciplines, including Vovinam from functioning. All the training centers are banned. All the masters either disperses or are drafted into the army. In general, Vovinam almost disappears due to lack of leadership. However, despite of the hardships, Master Tran Huy Phong still continues the missions set forth by the Founder. Therefore, he has created a task force of young, courageous instructors who become the foundation of Vovinam in the future. On November 1, , the Ngo Dinh Diem administration has fallen after a coup led by the military. Then a military government is established, and the ban of martial arts is annulled. All martial art disciplines are no longer being restricted, and starts to appear. In , all the leading Vovinam Masters has met and formed the new discipline of martial arts. Master Phan Quynh Treasurer: The program starts first in four public high schools: During this time, the new training curriculum is developed from Self-Defense to Master levels. The philosophical knowledge of Vovinam-Viet Vo Dao is also taught during class. Because of his good public relations and communication skills, Master Manh Hoang manages to secure two large centers for Vovinam-Viet Vo Dao from to April . There is a serious need for instructors. Many masters and instructors have to teach hours a day, seven days a week; even the third-degree blue belt students are required to teach. First many instructor-training classes are initiated in the National Police Headquarter, and the newly instructors are sent to the regional police departments to start Vovinam-Viet Vo Dao there. Upon hearing that decision, Vovinam-Viet Vo Dao declares that this is a shame to the Vietnamese martial arts of more than years. This vigil, widely supported by the media, touches the Vietnamese nationwide. Even the Military Intelligence Agency and the Presidential Political Bureau starts to investigate this event and the organizers. In the same year, Vovinamization of Rural Development Officials is initiated with the participation of tens of thousands of Rural Development Officials in Saigon and other provinces and villages. In early , during the Tet Offensive event, Vovinam-Viet Vo Dao helps many victims of war in Saigon. In , the Northwestern Instruction Commission is established in the province of Binh Duong under Master Ngo Kim Tuyen. Every year, on the occasion of the Commemorating Day of the late Founder, many masters everywhere return to Saigon to attend the Commemorating Ceremony as well as attend the special training sessions and promotion examinations. This creates a good tradition within Vovinam-Viet Vo Dao. The Grand Master and many high-level masters frequently visit many provinces, cities, and towns to support and examine the progress of Vovinam-Viet Vo Dao nationwide. The project creates more than residence unit to be sold to the disciples and friends. Besides, he and some friends form the Viet Vo Dao Agricultural Plant to harvest the agricultural produce for the village. The first Executive Committee includes Prof. Since early May , seeing the fall of South Vietnam, Grand Master officially proposed the blueprint to bring Vovinam overseas because he feared that the year achievement of Vovinam would be destroyed. Having many opportunities to leave Vietnam, the Grand Master and other senior masters are willing to stay in order to face the new challenges endangering Vovinam-Viet Vo Dao. During this period, Vovinam was almost disbanded; the other Masters either were imprisoned or halted teaching. Every year, the Vovinam-Viet Vo Dao Federation of Europe holds many special training sessions during the summer and winter. Late , Master Tran Huy Phong is released, but still under house arrest. In , the Grand Master is released

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from labor camp. As Vovinam became popular again in Vietnam, Vovinam disciples were allowed to compete in the Technical Tournament of the Third Region in This conference is attended by many masters and instructors representing Vovinam-Viet Vo Dao from different countries. After the workshop, many new assistant instructors return to their hometowns to start new training centers On April 29, , the Vietnamese regime establishes the Viet Vo Dao Commission to control Vovinam, and assigns a government official who is not a Vovinam disciple as the Commissioner. Because of this matter, all Vovinam Federations overseas declares that they would not comply to the puppet Viet Vo Dao Commission. Then he returned to Canari, Spain, to promote Vovinam there. His priceless contributions to Vovinam were remembered by all disciples.

After that our car will take you to Dong Ba Market: Dong Ba market is the biggest and most significant central market of Thua Thien – Hue province and the adjacent regions. In Dong Ba market, you can go shopping and see the daily life of local people. The tour finishes at about 4: Hue – Hoi An B Riddled with caves and shrines, they are said to each represent one of the five elements of the universe. Arrival Hoi An, check in your hotel and enjoy your relaxing time in this ancient town. Located in a lush valley, My Son now remains with red brick towers and sanctuaries. The ruins and temples of My Son have been dated as being from the 7th to the 13th century. During boat trip, you can witness the beautiful landscapes of Hoi An countryside.
