Other questions are harder, such as "What time will it be in 11 hours? If you want to test your knowledge of 15 minute intervals on the clock, choose level 2. At level 3 you will be tested on times including 5 minute intervals. A time is displayed at the top and you click on the clock face to move the hands. What Time is it? Train Times In this game from Count On you have to help Marty the mouse to catch the right train based on the time Marty wants to arrive and the length of the journey. You will have to answer some questions on time as you go along.
