Asian Studies Fall All courses are 5 credits unless otherwise noted. See the program requirements for specific information on how a particular course fits into your program of study.

Majors in Asian Studies become analysts of culture and history, learn how to relate the present to the past, and the past to the future. They analyze historical documents, learn to think contextually about social and ecological change, and to understand the history of the world as a group of systems, and as a single system. All majors must take the fourth semester of an Asian language Chinese, Japanese, Hindi, or Korean, as well as courses in Asian history, religion, literature or philosophy. Study abroad is not required, but it is highly encouraged. Double majoring in Asian Studies: Double majors in Chinese and Japanese must take at least two Asian Studies courses one of which must be at the level that focus on regional topics, or on countries that are not identical with their language major. Also, at least 12 credits cannot be double-counted in the double major. Study Abroad in Asia: Students can also find information on study abroad programs by visiting the Global Programs Website at: Recommended Academic Plan for Asian Studies: Select 4 credits beyond the 12th-credit level of proficiency in an Asian language: Select 3 credits from the following: Select 18 credits of courses related to Asia with at least 12 credits at the level. Courses not on the list that deal substantially with Asia in any discipline may also count, pending approval of the Asian Studies adviser. Students must earn a C or better in all courses applied to the major. Additional further credits in language studies may be permitted up to 6 credits credit received for a specific course will not count in more than one category Sem: Courses not on the list above may count toward the major. However, students must receive approval from the Asian Studies adviser to use other courses in the Asian Studies major. The approval process is not complex and can be done via e-mail.
