It is the Law of Cause and Effect. The Law of Cause and Effect says; "Every Cause has its Effect; every Effect has its Cause; everything happens according to Law; Chance is but a name for Law not recognized; there are many planes of causation, but nothing escapes the Law. This event building of the Tower of Babel happened approximately years after Noah came out of the Ark. Noah was still alive he lived years after exiting the Ark when this event happened and was recorded. The record opens by stating that the whole earth used the same language and words. Everyone understood what the other person was saying, there was agreement. As the people continue to increase in number, they began to spread out, moving east. They came upon a land where they decided to settle down and make a name for themselves. In their decision making process, they decided that they would build a tower to reach heaven and would use brick and tar to do it. The first point is they had a goal. They wanted to build a tower to reach heaven and they laid out a plan in which to do it. All of the brick layers knew what they were supposed to do, as did the carpenters, mortar workers and designers. Everyone was working together with one goal and one mind. They were in total agreement. The next part of the verse speaks to the why, they wanted to make a name for themselves so that they would not be scattered all over the earth. What is in a name? What does a name give you? Why do you think it was important for them to establish a name for themselves? Let me answer all three questions with this example. Every city and town has a history, a beginning. Every person has a birthplace and a family name. When you think about their situation, the name that they shared was the common name of their ancestor Noah. So there was not much differentiation between them. Those that decided to build this tower desired to set themselves apart while establishing a new family connection. Establishing a name would give them a place of reference, a place to call home. This tells you who I am by birth my name and it gives you the place to start your search on my background my hometown. This is what it gives you, but let me tell you what it gives me. It gives me a family not only in name, but in physical connection, as well as a childhood hometown. It gives me a place where I had a beginning, a place to belong. This is what they were seeking; the establishment of a place where they could be known separately from the other family members and it would also be a home for them. To accomplish this goal, they had to be in agreement which they were.

When you have been praying about something and do not seem to be making any progress, you may need to get someone to pray in agreement with you. When two or more people come into agreement, Jesus Himself promises to be with them, and His presence exerts more power than we can imagine in our lives and in our circumstances. Jesus said in Matthew 20, "For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them. We need to understand the power of unity and agreement, and though we do need private times of intimate communion with God, we also need to exercise the power of praying in agreement with others. Living in Agreement The prayer of agreement is only effective when those who come into agreement in prayer are living in agreement in their natural everyday lives. Living in agreement does not mean we cannot ever have our own opinions about everything, but it does mean that there is harmony, mutual respect, and honor in our relationships. It means that there is an absence of the things that cause division and strife - like selfishness, anger, resentment, jealousy, bitterness, or comparison. Living in agreement is like being on the same ball team - everyone works together, supports and encourages each other, believes each other, and trusts each other as they all pursue the same goal and share the victory. There may exist differing opinions or disagreement over issues but a commitment must be made to avoid strife and division in our relationships, even if it means "agreeing to disagree" to maintain honor and respect for one another. Even in ministry, the vision for that ministry should be communicated to the ministry team so that when decisions are made, the team members do so in agreement with the vision God has given for that ministry. In this way, all of the team members are praying and working in agreement with the God-given purpose of the ministry as they will experience great blessings and will be used to bless others as well. Living in Agreement is Not Maintaining unity and harmony does require effort, but the power released when people pray who live in agreement is worth it. God is honored when we commit to living in unity because He knows it is not always easy. Be a maker and maintainer of peace and you will be called a son of God Matthew 5: Pray to God In Luke One was a Pharisee and the other one was a tax collector. Jesus said, "The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, of even as this publican I give tithes of all that I possess. And the publican standing afar off would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. Sometimes we pray to impress people - to impress them with our eloquence. When we are praying in agreement with someone else or with a group of people, we have to be very careful that we are not preaching to the other people and that we are not simply trying to sound superspiritual, but that our prayers are led by the Spirit and that we are really sharing our hearts with God. Agreement is incredibly powerful, but it has to be pure, and it has to come from a place of humility. Multiplied Power Jesus has promised that if two people on earth agree about something, God will bring it to pass Matthew As already mentioned, He answers prayers of agreement when the people who are praying are already expressing agreement in their everyday lives. The power of your agreement is so dynamic that you are going to break through - no doubt about it. Agreement is so powerful that it is a principle of multiplication, not addition. That is why the Bible says that one person can put a thousand to flight and two can put ten thousand. If agreement were based on addition, one would put a thousand to flight and two would put two thousand to flight. For that reason, the prayer of true agreement is a strong and mighty force in the spiritual realm. The prayer of agreement is indeed a type of prayer that releases multiplied power, and praying this way will have

tremendous results in your life. Right agreement results in light and good; wrong agreement results in darkness and evil. If we flirt with the law of gravity by dancing, fighting, or sleeping on the edge of a cliff and we fall off-frantic prayer will not stop us from being smashed into oblivion at the foot of that cliff. We ignored the obvious consequences of the law of gravity. We must not flirt with words of wrong agreement and ignore their consequences. We are better off to be silent than create darkness and evil with our words. In the third chapter of Acts we read that as Peter and John entered the Temple through the Gate Beautiful, they saw a man begging alms. Peter told the man to look at them. Expecting to receive a coin, he looked, and Peter told him, "Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk. Peter took the man by the hand, lifted him up, and the man started walking. He entered the Temple praising God. This raised a stir among the people, and Peter and John were taken before the priests and elders. They were cast into prison, and the next day were taken before the rulers. Unable to deny that a true miracle had taken place, the priests were forced to let them go. However, they commanded them not to preach or teach in the Name of Jesus anymore. And when they heard that, they lifted up their voice to God with one accord, and said, Lord, thou art God, which hast made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all that in them is: Who by the mouth of thy servant David has said, Why did the heathen rage, and the people imagine vain things? For to do whatsoever thy hand and thy counsel determined before to be done. And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: Notice the first thing Peter and John did when they were released from the prison: Christians today would probably organize a committee to go talk to those leaders and make a deal whereby everyone could get along. However, the Bible says, " Was their united prayer answered? They had not asked the Lord to make their way easy. Instead they had prayed that in the midst of persecution they might preach the Word with boldness. And the Lord had answered their prayer. Verse 31 says that " If Christians today would get together and pray "with one accord" they would shake the world for Jesus. There is power in united prayer! Notice too, that their prayer was for something specific. They were definite in their praying. They were not praying some generalized prayer; they were praying about the need that faced them. And they all prayed at once. As they lifted their voices to God in fervent prayer, "the place was shaken. Instead of complaining to the Lord about what had happened to them, they lifted their voices to the Lord in songs of praise. They, too, were praying aloud, for "the prisoners heard them. The prisoners heard them as they sang praises unto God. Some people say they want to pray quietly because the Lord knows they have a song in their heart. But, if it is there, it is going to come out, " Did God answer the united prayer of Paul and Silas? When Paul and Silas joined forces in prayer and praise to God, the very foundations of the prison were shaken. The stocks came off their feet, and they were free. The jailer, awakened by the earthquake, saw the prison doors standing open and assumed the prisoners had fled. He knew he would be held responsible for their escape, and he became so frightened that he was going to kill himself. Just then Paul cried out, " Do thy self no harm: The jailer knew he had witnessed the supernatural that night. He knew Paul and Silas were no ordinary men, and he " And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house. There is supernatural power in united prayer! Your Word says that if any two of you agree on earth about anything that they may ask, it shall be done for them by My Father who is in heaven. The case of the rancher who had been praying that his ranch foreman and family might be saved. To humble ourselves and call on the name of the Lord, standing in agreement prayer, releases something powerful and supernatural in the invisible.

Page 2 of 3 The Cross and Unity Jesus came to die for individuals, but His cross also made possible miracle-working relationships. His cross reconciles all divisions. Before His death and resurrection, Jesus gave a hint about miracle power in Matthew For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them. If we can agree, anything becomes possible! Yet Satan has convinced the Western world that individualism, self-assertion and self-interest are the way. In the communist world, he has divided people into the educated elites and the so-called workers or masses. Here humans lose their souls. The truth is that the cross redeems the individual and then reconciles that person with all the redeemed. In this new level of agreement, miracles become possible. In John 15, Jesus teaches us that connections count: As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing" vv. First, we must abide in the vine. Using the image of a vineyard, Jesus views believers as clusters of tasty grapes on a flourishing vine. Each grape is delicious, but together they can produce something more valuable: God removes the protective hedge, and the vineyard is wasted! Later, Isaiah reminds the people of the favor that is released in the cluster of grapes: The prophet Micah mourns the loss of unity under the same image of the cluster of grapes: For I am like those who gather summer fruits, like those who glean vintage grapes; there is no cluster to eat of the first-ripe fruit which my soul desires. The faithful man has perished from the earth, and there is no one upright among men. They all lie in wait for blood; every man hunts his brother with a net" Mic. God is looking for the cluster and instead finds brother pitted against brother. This terrible scene shows how the blessing is forfeited and mourns the absence of new wine. No wonder Jesus did such extensive teaching in John 15 on the vine and branches! It is amazing that Jesus uses the word agreement to describe our relationships. The Greek word is *sumphoneo*. *Sum* is the word together, and *phoneo* is voice or say. We get our word *symphony* from this word. It means to let the same word of faith go forth from all of us in harmony. Every instrument in an orchestra is different, but when all the instruments are led by a capable conductor, the music is miraculous. This is the kind of harmony that is sweet to the ears of God. This kind of relationship makes miracles possible. God loves this kind of unity: It is like the precious oil upon the head, running down on the beard, the beard of Aaron, running down on the edge of his garments. It is like the dew of Hermon, descending upon the mountains of Zion; for there the Lord commanded the blessingâ€”life forevermore" Ps. In this psalm, we learn that God commands not a blessing but the blessing when He beholds a people in unity. This psalm gives a prophetic view of the church clothed in the garments of the High Priest, with the anointing of power flowing from the Head, Jesus. As the church walks in unity, blessings flow off the Head to the hem of the garment. What a picture and promise! Jesus came to bring reconciliation. In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus declares that our offerings will not bring a harvest until we reconcile with our brothers Matt. This was what was on His great heart right before His bloody death. The whole prayer is in the plural, including us all!

The ongoing relationship between God and Gideon is all about growing in agreement and coming into destiny. In the end Gideon does obey God, although not perfectly, and brings the people of God into great victory. Agreement brings about a wonderful and harmonious experience of unity between God and each other. So as we study Neh 10, we will seek to discover how was the power of agreement made practical. The first 28 verses of chapter 10 in Nehemiah records the names of those who came to agreement after having read from the Law. We see the people putting agreement into action is in relation towards the Word of God - Neh The question arises, should Christians today, in the pursuit of unity and agreement bind themselves with such strong oaths or vows? Our Father in Heaven is seeking those who will love him shown by a demonstration of obedience to his Scriptures. The motivation of our obedience is our love for God and the manifestation of our obedience is joy in bringing pleasure to God. The message of the New Testament is simple - the grace of God and promises of God lead to a fulfilled life. By the way, a fulfilled life does not mean one free from struggles, trials, temptations or persecutions. The abundant fulfilled life is a joining to the Kingdom of God and walking with the King through the joys and struggles of life. Therefore we must be people of the Wordâ€™ The word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart hebrews 4: All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, 17 so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work 2 Tim 3: For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through endurance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope Rom Agreement as the people of God In the times of Nehemiah the people of God were confronted by all kinds of social, business and religious practices of the Persian Empire. While some of the interaction with this Empire would be good in that law and order was provided, other idolatrous effects of this pagan nation troubled the people of God. In other words, the people of God let the Word of God define their surrounding culture and not the other way around. There were two specific areas that the Jewish people struggled against. The main concern of inter-marriage with Gentiles was the loss of pure devotion to God. The Jew or Gentile spouses would have different ideas of faith, dietary laws, or the celebration of the Jewish annual festivals. To put this into a more contemporary context, there are times when I have been asked to perform a wedding between a Christian and an unsaved person. I challenge the Christian to consider the Biblical verses both Old and New Testament that warn of troubles in this type of marriage. The Sabbath day was one of the expressions of Jewish culture in contrast to other nations. We know from Scripture that God rested on the seventh day making it a day of rest and reflection Gen 2: The Sabbath day was incorporated into the 10 Commandments number 4 so that the people of God would personally rest, along with the land and animals etc, and reflect on their relationship with God. Some of the Jewish businessmen interested in making money were falling into temptation and sin by buying and selling on the Sabbath. Not to have extra produce for a whole year would certainly affect their

business with the Gentiles around them. This kind of radical commitment in the midst of a pagan Empire was a demonstration of true devotion. How did they care for the house of God? The tax was a reminder to the people that God had redeemed them and paid a price to set them free, and that they should behave like people who belonged to God. The wood offering Neh. First-fruits is all about bringing your best to God. Firstfruits also reminded the Jews that God saved the firstborn Jews from death in the land of Egypt. Teaching on the tithe can go into greater detail yet the main point to highlight is that the Jews agreed to commit once again to tithes. I cannot say enough about reading and studying the Holy Bible. We must be people who seek out God through his Scriptures letting God speak to our lives and circumstances and culture. The kingdom of God is meant to shape our lives and culture, not the other way around. They set their affection on God above their affection for their unbelieving spouses. They did the same for the Sabbath thereby trusting in God as their provider, not their business pursuits. They also reaffirmed their commitment to the house of God by giving of their resources in four ways, the temple tax, the wood offering, firstfruits and the tithe. There are different views relating to tithing in modern church; some say yes and some say no. For me the discussion is not about tithing but about New Testament giving. People under Old Testament Law tithed, how much more ought we to give today who live under the New Covenant grace?

Jesus is in complete agreement with God, His Father, who is in heaven. Can we assume that this agreement is a major key to Jesus success? Power of agreement leaves an impression! What does this have to do with me? One of those people is the woman with the issue of blood Mk 5: She knows that Jesus is filled with the healing power of God that is to be poured out on the afflicted. In knowing this, the woman has come into agreement with Jesus for healing. Her affliction of twelve years is gone. Power of agreement merging with the force of faith causes the supernatural power of Heaven to overthrow the natural circumstances of this afflicted woman. The story of the woman with the issue of blood is woven into another story of agreement. It is the saga of Jairus, the synagogue ruler whose daughter is at the point of death Mk 5: He is desperate to get Jesus to his house to lay hands on his daughter, that the little girl might be healed and live. Then, the procession is stilled by Jesus interaction with the woman, who has laid hold of His healing power. The crowds seem to be in agreement with one another that this is quite a spectacle. If there had been agreement for healing in the crowd, there would have been lots of healings take place on the road. A point to be understood here is that standing close enough to observe does not constitute agreement. Agreement is revelation of the truth before us, combined with the force of faith that rises from our hearts.. So, it is no surprise that Jesus slips away from the crowd with only Peter, James, and John. Jesus knows what these three have in them, what He can expect from them. Word has come that the little girl is dead. He calls for life just as His Father had called forth life in the beginning: Such a renewing process takes time, but is so worth the investment. Chapter 8 : What Does the Bible Say About Agreement?

The Power of Agreement: First of all I want to give some definition to the power of agreement and help us to understand that there are several words that compliment this word; harmony, accordance (similar in thought or feeling), unity, or an arrangement that is accepted by all parties.

By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh, Genesis And as people migrated from the east, they found a plain in the land of Shinar and settled there. Do nothing from rivalry or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, Romans After agreeing with the laborers for a denarius a day, he sent them into his vineyard. Going out again about the sixth hour and the ninth hour, he did the same. The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. And God saw that the light was good. And God separated the light from the darkness. God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And there was evening and there was morning, the first day. Truly, I say to you, there will not be left here one stone upon another that will not be thrown down. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. Then you may rise up early and go on your way. And he made them a feast and baked unleavened bread, and they ate. Chapter 9 : 19 Bible verses about Agreement, Before God

We will begin by looking at Jesus' statement regarding the power of agreement in prayer. Believers Can Legally Place a Demand on Their Covenant The word that Jesus used for "agree" in the above verse literally means "to stipulate (demand) by contract, to arrange definitively by covenant."

In this lesson we will study how and when to pray the Prayer of Agreement. For where two or three are gathered together in My name, there am I in the midst of them. These are Covenant words. Whatever they are promising is about to come to pass. Almighty God will personally cause His Word to come to pass whenever someone has placed a demand on it, if He has to slap Heaven and Earth together to get the job done. I am simply trying to illustrate a point. My point is that nowhere in the Bible are we ever instructed to demand anything from God. However, we are instructed to place a demand on our Covenant with God. There is a major difference. I do not drink soda. But if I did, I could walk up to a soda machine, place my money in the slot, hit the button of my choice and place a demand on that machine. I am completely within my jurisdiction in doing so. I gave the machine my money. Now it is time for the machine to keep its end of the agreement and produce. I have a Covenant with Almighty God. When I find something in the Bible that He has agreed to do for me, I place a demand on that provision, not on God. I have given my life to our Covenant. He promises that the Covenant will recompense me and produce. Again, I do not place a demand on Holy God. I place a demand on our Covenant and it produces. Multiplied Power through Agreement No matter how much I understand my Covenant with my Father, no matter how powerful I might be in prayer based on that understanding, my prayer power can be multiplied no less than ten-fold by getting into agreement with another faithful Believer. This is true for anyone. We find this principle revealed in a victory prayer prayed by Moses. For their rock is not as our Rock, even our enemies themselves being judges. The following is a much more literal translation. If one is able to chase one thousand enemies and two are able to chase ten thousand enemies, then that is a ten-fold increase. One Believer can set a thousand demon spirits running by getting a hold of a specific Covenant promise in any area of their life and refusing to let go of it. Find a partner who will not back down from the written Word of God even when all Hell breaks loose. You will see God move in ways that you never imagined possible. We have friends who call us for agreement when it is time for them to place a demand on the Covenant and they know they need more power. We call those very same friends when it is time for us to place a demand on the Covenant and we know we need more power. We have found this to be tremendously effective. Every Believer should have someone that they can call on for unwavering agreement in prayer. Just keep the sin out of your life and be sure you choose a partner who is aware of the powerlessness of sin as well. Repent when you blow it. Get back into agreement and this prayer will work for you every time. It comes with a personal guarantee from the Son of Almighty God. If you do not know how to pray the Prayer of Agreement, it goes like this. Keep your words in agreement with what you prayed. Praise Him and thank Him with every thought of your agreement. God will then do a big thing and demonstrate Himself strong on your behalf. God wants to answer your prayer. He wants you to be encouraged. God wants you to have confidence in the powerful Prayer of Agreement. He wants you to tell others all about how powerful it really is. John and Barbara Hamel.
