Bayne-Jones felt that her bacteriology research was significant. She earned the degree in from the University, and her thesis was published in the Journal of Bacteriology. Mom loved music, particularly opera and violin. She would listen to the Metropolitan Opera every Saturday afternoon while she baked fresh bread; with our late brother, we grew up on that musical Saturday tradition. Mom was also an accomplished horsewoman and a talented seamstress who made most of her own clothesâ€”with such skill that it was difficult to tell them from the work of designers. She always loved to travel. When she was a child, President Rhees and the family traveled to Egypt and Hawaii. Later, she went on many journeys with her late husband, Dr. John Stewart, and even in her 90s went on a trip with her family to Alaska. She had a wonderful sense of humor that bubbled up at the most unlikely times, often turning a mishap into a hilarious story. She was also incredibly resourceful, a quality that served her frugal instincts well. When something broke, instead of having it repaired or buying a replacement, she would find an ingenious way to fix it herself. Mom was a devoted daughter and wife, and a fond sister to her two brothers, both of whom died before her. She lived independently, humbly, and with a clear mind until she passed away on April 12, , at the age of
