The bikes are bigger, contain more power, more torque, and are harder to control than the bikes in the lower class. The bikes in the SX can outjump the smaller bikes and can make passes accelerating harder out of turns. Thus, the fastest riders fans will see at Anaheim 1 will all compete in the SX class. Supercross is related to Motocross but contains off-road motorcycles which compete on indoor, man-made tracks consisting of steep jumps and a series of

obstacles. Supercross race tracks tend to be constructed inside large sports stadiums. AMA Supercross falls under the broad term motorcycle sport. The other riders are relegated to the consolation race, known as the Last Chance Qualifier, which is three minutes plus one lap, with the top four advancing to the feature. The feature race is 15 minutes plus one lap in the cc class, and 20 minutes plus one lap for the cc class, with 25 championship points for the race win. At three races in the second Anaheim, and also the Minneapolis and Atlanta rounds , a three-heat format will be used six, ten, and twelve minutes for cc, eight, twelve, and fifteen minutes for cc , and rules similar to the Monster Energy Cup individual heat scoring will determine the overall race winner. Standard rules apply, with the feature race being 10 laps. Starting in , the combined East-West Shootout will also be held in the middle of the season, at the Indianapolis round. If at any point during the Heat Races, LCQs or the Feature Races, that the race is red-flagged within less than 3 laps, the race will be a complete restart. Track[edit] Among the obstacles, riders must navigate through every lap. The track takes a combination of obstacles such as whoop sections where riders skim along the tops of multiple bumps , rhythm sections irregular series of jumps with a variety of combination options , and triple jumps three jumps in a row that riders normally clear in a single leap of 70 feet or more. Many of the turns have banked berms , but some are flat. It takes roughly five hundred truckloads of dirt to make up a supercross track. Soil conditions can be hard-packed, soft, muddy, sandy, rutted, or any combination thereof.
