

Chapter 1 : Butterfly Alphabet Poster

The Butterfly Alphabet and The Nature Alphabet are collections of symbols found on the wings of butterflies and in unexpected places in nature. The posters, books, prints and gifts for sale on this site have inspired the world -- particularly children -- to see meaning in the tiniest details of nature.

Tweet 64 Shares Spring is right around the corner. I can see signs of it. Even though it snowed yesterday, there are a few blades of Spring green grass and some of the trees are starting to grow leaves. Our activity was inspired in one of the Dollar Spot aisles of Target, where we found these adorable wood butterflies. I took them home, grabbed a permanent marker and wrote one letter on each butterfly. Because I only bought two packs, we only have 24 butterflies, so I doubled the letters front and back on two of the butterflies to have one for every letter. Children can pick a butterfly, recognize and name the letter, find the corresponding letter on the ABC mat, then trace the letter. We first did this activity with uppercase to uppercase matching and tracing. There is also a lowercase letter mat when the child is ready for this challenge. Print the mat with the blue button below. If you plan to use this mat multiple times, laminating it and using dry erase markers would work great. These can be printed and cut to use for the same idea. These could also be laminated to increase longevity of use. Activity Variations This activity can be adapted for children who are just beginning to explore the alphabet all the way to children who are learning to write each letter. Some children may not be ready to trace. These mats can still be used and the wood butterfly can be placed on top of the corresponding letter. If using the printable butterflies, have the child point to or circle the matching letter. Another variation is to use uppercase on the butterflies and lowercase on the printable ABC mat, or vice versa. Even more of a challenge would be to have the child say a word or a few words that start with that letter. My daughter enjoyed this activity so much we did more of it later in the day.
