There is, at least if this book is evidence, not pages worth of interesting stuff to dig up regarding thanks. I confess to having skimmed great swaths in the middle. I was, though, amused by a passage on breastfeeding, which implied that breastfed children learn gratitude at the breast. From the blurb I was expecting a lot more. But essentially, this book is limited to gift-giving. Towards the end it becomes a little too Christian. I wanted it to stay more detached so I could form my own opinion. I wanted more anthropological evidence. This time, the subject is gratitude. When I first started, I thought, "This is her best yet! But for me, it went on a little too long, and got a little too repetitive. Still, it was NOT a waste of time!
