Meanwhile Colonel Georges Picquart, head of counter-espionage, found evidence in March indicating that the real traitor was Major Ferdinand Walsin Esterhazy. The General Staff, however, refused to reconsider its judgment and transferred Picquart to North Africa. Scheurer-Kestner reported three months later that he was convinced of the innocence of Dreyfus and also persuaded Georges Clemenceau, a former MP and then a newspaper reporter. While the circle of Dreyfusards widened, in January two nearly simultaneous events gave a national dimension to the case: France became increasingly divided over the case, and the issue continued to be hotly debated until the end of the century. Antisemitic riots erupted in more than twenty French cities. There were several deaths in Algiers. The Republic was shaken, which prompted a sense that the Dreyfus Affair had to be resolved to restore calm and protect the stability of the nation. Despite the intrigues of the army to quash the case, the first judgment against Dreyfus was annulled by the Supreme Court after a thorough investigation and a new court-martial was held at Rennes in Despite increasingly robust evidence to the contrary, Dreyfus was convicted again and sentenced to ten years of hard labour, though the sentence was commuted due to extenuating circumstances. It was only in that his innocence was officially recognized through a decision without recourse by the Supreme Court. He died in The implications of this case were numerous and affected all aspects of French public life. In politics, the affair established the triumph of the Third Republic and became a founding myth; [3] in the renewal of nationalism, in the military. In religion, it slowed the reform of French Catholicism and republican integration of Catholics; and in social, legal, press, diplomatic and cultural life. It was during the affair that the term intellectual was coined. The affair engendered numerous antisemitic demonstrations, which in turn affected emotions within the Jewish communities of Central and Western Europe. These demonstrations affected the international movement of Zionism by persuading one of its founding fathers, Theodor Herzl , that the Jews must leave Europe and establish their own state. Political[edit] In, the Third Republic was twenty-four years old. The elections of were focused on the "social question" and resulted in a Republican victory just under half the seats against the conservative right and the reinforcement of the Radicals about seats and Socialists about 50 seats. The opposition of the Radicals and Socialists resulted in a centrist government with policies oriented towards economic protectionism, a certain indifference to social issues, a willingness to break international isolation, the Russian alliance, and development of the colonial empire. This instability coincided with an equally unstable presidency: His government faced the opposition of the left and of some Republicans including the Progressive Union and made sure to keep the support of the right. He sought to appease religious, social, and economic tensions and conducted a fairly conservative policy. He succeeded in improving stability, and it was under this stable government that the Dreyfus Affair occurred. The traumatic defeat in seemed far away, but a vengeful spirit remained. Many participants in the Dreyfus Affair were Alsatian. The army had recovered from the defeat but many of its officers were aristocrats and monarchists. Cult of the flag and contempt for the parliamentary republic prevailed in the army. Over the previous ten years the army had experienced a significant shift in its twofold aim to democratize and modernize. The period was also marked by an arms race that primarily affected artillery. Spying as a tool for secret war was a novelty as an organised activity in the late 19th century. The Statistics Section was created in but consisted of only a handful of officers and civilians. Its military mission was clear: The arms race created an acute atmosphere of intrigue in French counter-espionage from One of the missions of the section was to spy on the German Embassy at Rue de Lille in Paris to thwart any attempt to transmit important information to the Germans. At the time of the Dreyfus Affair there were an estimated Jewish officers in the army about 3 per cent of the total, of whom ten were generals. When a series of press articles in La Libre Parole [14] accused some brilliant Jewish officers of "betraying their birth", the officers challenged the editors. Hatred of Jews was now public and violent, driven by a firebrand Drumont who demonized the Jewish presence in France. Jews in metropolitan France in numbered about 80, 40, in Paris alone, who were highly integrated into society; an additional 45, Jews lived in Algeria. The only way to eliminate the threat of anything disrupting our personal peace is to take responsibility for meeting our own needs. It is in reading the back matter of a book that you discover things about an author which make you go "oh Renshaw is a martial artist explains the believable manoeuvers by which Veronica defies physical disadvantages to punch significantly above her weight. When queried about whether there were naughty bits in his book, the author replied "As far as naughty bits are concerned, that depends on your definition. There are several references to sex, more so than I have seen in many of my recent reads. But the references are about its anticipation and its aftermath and Renshaw manages to conjure a convincing image of a young woman with perhaps slightly more than her fair share of adolescent urges but without ever descending to prurient detail. There is no harm in that. I dare say that a profound knowledge of designer shopping made 50 Shades of Grey a more credible read to those who delved into its reportedly shallow depths. Suffice to say there are some scenes that are not for Public Eyes. There is resolution of a kind for all the victims in this story. However, the need to weave the back and the forward story together in a relatively short volume means that the forward story falls short of the absolute resolution that a purist might have hankered after. Indeed, at one point I was worried as to how far the author was going to leave me hanging by my fingernails on a fearful cliff-hanger of an ending. In the absence of the convenience of an amazon kindle version I had resorted to buying the book in a physical paperback. Others may feel the same, but I would only say do not judge a book by its cover, or at least not this one, because it is better than that. The book declares, in its subtitle, that this is Book One of the Chandler Affairs. It is inevitably an introduction to the heroine and her snow clad milieu of Calgary. An entertaining and well written read in its own right, but also something of a showcase for what will follow with characters from all ends of the good-bad spectrum surely set to reappear. Yes - it passes the simple tests I believe in the characters even the oddest of them I care about what happens to them and I want to see how the story pans out. Along the way it is well written with some sharply observed dialogue and a credible seasoning of detail to flesh out but not pad out the narrative.
