What is the significance of the twelve gates in Revelation 21? The twelve gates in Revelation 21 belong to the New Jerusalem, which comes down from heaven to the new earth verse 10, shining with the glory of God verse 17. John describes the city: The gates are miraculous in their construction: And the gates of the New Jerusalem will never be never shut verse 10. In order to understand the significance of the twelve gates being inscribed with the names of the twelve tribes, we must look to the beginning of the Old Testament, when God promised a new land and a great nation to Abraham, whose descendants would spread blessing upon all other nations Genesis 12:1-3. Those twelve tribes escaped slavery in Egypt, inherited the Promised Land Exodus 6:1-8. Revelation speaks of the New Jerusalem that has been prepared for the reign of the Lamb Revelation 21:2-3. This New Jerusalem sits on twelve foundations, representing the twelve apostles who would reign over the twelve tribes of Israel verse 14; cf. The gates of the city are symmetrically arranged: Each gate of the New Jerusalem bears the inscription of one of the tribes of Israel, and each gate is guarded by an angel Revelation 21:12-13. Many scholars see a link between the New Jerusalem, with its three gates per side, and the city of the millennial kingdom, seen by the prophet Ezekiel: Beginning on the north side. The three gates on the north side will be the gate of Reuben, the gate of Judah and the gate of Levi. On the east side. On the south side. On the west side. See also Numbers 2, where God specified that three tribes would encamp on each side of the tent of meeting in the wilderness. So what are we to make of all this? The gates of the New Jerusalem are inscribed with the names of the twelve tribes of Israel. Israel was chosen by God to be a light to all nations Isaiah 49:6. The New Jerusalem thus contains a tribute to the patriarchs of Israel. It also contains a tribute to the apostles Revelation 21:14. Romans 9 makes a distinction between physical descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob and their spiritual descendantsâ€”i. Just as not all Gentiles come to the light of the world, some Jews choose to live in darkness: Those who have faith in Christ are accounted the spiritual seed of Abraham Galatians 3:29. Angels are at the gates of the New Jerusalem. Nothing evil or impure will ever enter the New Jerusalem Revelation 21:27. Each gate of the New Jerusalem is made of a single pearl. The richness and supernatural nature of the city is profound. This is the city that is worth more than anything this present world has to offer. Its builder and maker is God Hebrews 11:10. The gates of the New Jerusalem never close. There are eternal safety and peace in the New Jerusalem; there are no enemies to shut the gates against.
