As the only known entrance from the Atlantic, the Strait of Magellan was at times patrolled by fleets sent to prevent entrance of non-Spanish ships. Growing imperialism during the 19th century resulted in the occupation of much of Oceania by European powers, and later Japan and the United States. By occupying Easter Island, Chile joined the imperial nations. However, by the end of that war, Japan was defeated and the U. Pacific Fleet was the virtual master of the ocean. Anvil tops of thunderclouds are also visible. The Pacific separates Asia and Australia from the Americas. It may be further subdivided by the equator into northern North Pacific and southern South Pacific portions. It extends from the Antarctic region in the South to the Arctic in the north. By contrast, the Atlantic Ocean is increasing in size. However, the Pacific is not always peaceful. Many tropical storms batter the islands of the Pacific.
