The story, however, is not found in the Bible and does not appear in its present form until the Middle Ages. For this reason, it is unlikely to be historical. She wiped the sweat off his face with her veil and the image of his face was allegedly imprinted on the cloth. However, there is no reference to the story of Veronica and her veil in the canonical Gospels. It is also at this point that other depictions of the image change to include a crown of thorns, blood, and the expression of a man in pain. However, mosaics that decorated that chapel do not refer to the Veronica story in any way. Furthermore, contemporaneous writers make no reference to the Veil in this period. It would appear, however, that the Veronica was in place by C. Shortly after that, in , the cloth became more prominent when it was publicly paraded and displayed by Pope Innocent III in , who also granted indulgences to anyone praying before it. During this Jubilee, the Veronica was publicly displayed and became one of the "Mirabilia Urbis" "wonders of the City" for the pilgrims who visited Rome. For the next two hundred years, the Veronica was regarded as the most precious of all Christian relics. Messer Unbano to the Duchess of Urbino say that the Veronica was stolen and passed around the taverns of Rome. One witness to the sacking says that the Veronica was not found by the looters. His edict declared that anyone who had access to a copy must bring it to the Vatican, under penalty of excommunication. After that time, the Veil disappears almost entirely from public view, and its history following that date is unrecorded. Very few inspections have been recorded in modern times. In , Jesuit art historian Joseph Wilpert was allowed to remove two plates of glass to inspect the image. He commented that he saw only "a square piece of light colored material, somewhat faded through age, which bear two faint rust-brown stains, connected one to the other. Through a process of 3D negative filming that he previously used on the Shroud of Turin , the injured face of Christ was revealed. Each member of this group is enclosed in an elaborate outer frame with a gilded metal sheet or riza in Russian within, in which is cut an aperture where the face appears; at the lower extreme of the face there are three points which correspond to the shape of the hair and beard. The face is still displayed each year on the occasion of the 5th Sunday of Lent, Passion Sunday. This veil was given by a Vatican cardinal to a

Spanish priest, Mosen Pedro Mena, who took it to Alicante, in southern Spain, where it arrived in 1531, at the same time as a severe drought. Carried in a procession on March 17, by an Alicante priest, Father Villafranca, a tear sprang from the eye of the face of Christ on the veil and rain began to fall. The chapel is decorated with paintings depicting the miraculous termination of the drought, local personalities associated with the founding of the chapel and religious themes of judgment and salvation. The Monastery was extensively restored between 1531 and 1532, together with the Cathedral of Saint Nicholas and the Basilica of St Mary in the city centre, and the three buildings housed an exhibition in about 1532 of the relic under the name of The Face of Eternity. It is kept in a shrine by the high altar and is annually exhibited to the people on Good Friday and on the Feast of the Assumption. It is known as the Santo Rostro and was acquired by Bishop Nicholas de Biedma in the fourteenth century. It has been the subject of a detailed study by Colette Dufour Bozzo, who dated the outer frame to the late fourteenth century, [15] while the inner frame and the image itself are believed to have originated earlier. Bozzo found that the image was imprinted on a cloth that had been pasted onto a wooden board. Holy Face of S. Silvestro up to and is now kept in the Matilda chapel in the Vatican. It is housed in a Baroque frame donated by one Sister Dionora Chiarucci in 1660. Like the Genoa image, it is painted on board and therefore is likely to be a copy. The Manoppello Image In 1931, Father Heinrich Pfeiffer announced at a press conference in Rome that he had found the Veil in a church of the Capuchin monastery, in the small village of Manoppello, Italy, where it had been since 1631. Professor Pfeiffer had in fact been promoting this image for many years before. Professor Pfeiffer claims that the image is the Veronica itself, which he suggests was stolen from the Vatican during rebuilding that took place in 1631. Additionally he has suggested a history of the veil going back to the first Century. The cloth is made of a rare fiber called byssus, which is linen woven from a fine, yellowish flax referred to as sea silk, and used by ancient Egyptians and Hebrews. Some feel that, despite claims of divine origins, the face on the veil at Manoppello conforms in appearance to the characteristics of a man-made image. Additionally, there is no evidence connecting the cloth with Rome. There are two main traditions for the iconography of the face depicted on the veil. One tradition Type I, common in Italian art, shows the face of Christ as full-bearded, in pain, scourged and perhaps crowned with thorns. Holy Face Giambono, fifteenth century. Not only do you have to beat the usual stuff in M3 games like breaking chains, background tiles, and bringing down items off the board you must kill monsters within the tokens by matching their color token. This makes you have to be super quick because they are generated every few seconds. Time is of the essence and there is no relaxed play only a more difficult mode called Nightmare. You do get lots of power ups but they are generated so slowly you cannot keep up with the drain on you health. Also the bosses you must beat after every so many levels are invincible. Your health meter runs out super quick while the bosses health barely takes a dent. It took me about 5 hours to beat a boss and this was only the 8th level!!! No I call it frustrating and not fun at all. But if you like this type of difficulty then this is a game for you. Pick your power ups wisely because they are randomly generated on one meter and thrown anywhere on the board. Then you have to maneuver to make a match from them. You do not get to place them. They are generated by making matches quickly and when meter is full it gives you any one of the items you purchased in the store. If you pause matching the meter sinks back down. I hated this feature. After trial and error I made another profile and started over only choosing the heart for health and one that would zap the monsters. There is also a potion cauldron which was necessary to win. It would give you Health by matching red tokens, a shield from two hits by monsters for matching green tokens a freeze from damage for blue and another color you could only buy after reaching a certain level I have not achieved yet nor may ever. These power ups also generated slowly and you had to remember to click on them to activate once they were full. All that while you are desperately trying to concentrate on the board matching. Ugh this game just proved too much for me. You get coins from winning the levels and can upgrade the store items but only after reaching certain levels, Why?? This is a game only a masochist would love. Maybe if I had purchased the game and seen it through to the end, I would have "gotten" it. The graphics were ok The music was odd. The sound effects were ghostly "aahhs" and what seemed like the sound of "pops" or "punches". Definitely disconcerting to me. You earn coins by successfully passing levels, which you STOP doing by level 8. Trust me on this. Up through level 5, things are pretty simple.
